

### Who we Are



ICEERS is a nonprofit organization with United Nations Consultative status, founded in 2009, that focus on the challenges arising from the globalization of traditional Indigenous medicines. For over 16 years, ICEERS has worked at the frontlines mitigating harms and defending rights—supporting over 390 legal cases in 47 countries, assisting nearly 2,000 individuals in need of integration and crisis support, and responding to more than 1,200 medical and drug interaction queries. ICEERS has provided harm reduction and integration education to over 1,000 practitioners and facilitated 60 workshops in a dozen countries, increasing safety and ethics through community-building processes that foster a culture of care, accountability and self-regulation. ICEERS has published over 100 scientific papers and educational resources, participated in dozens of United Nations processes, and worked with government agencies to support the creation of just policies. The organization has also provided technical support to Indigenous-led initiatives focused on biocultural conservation and Indigenous rights, and has convened three international ayahuasca conferences to foster global alliance and dialogue. Our vision is a future in which the stewardship of Indigenous medicines is guided by a collaborative, intercultural, and interdisciplinary movement on a global scale.

The **Yorenka Tasorentsi Institute**, founded in 2018 by Ashaninka leader Benki Piyãko, is an Indigenous-led center for ecological regeneration, cultural revitalization, and political advocacy. Located in the Brazilian Amazon, the institute blends traditional Ashaninka knowledge with innovative agroforestry and sustainability practices to restore biodiversity and support food security in the region. Yorenka serves as a hub for environmental education, Indigenous self-determination, and the protection of sacred medicines and ancestral knowledge systems. It plays a leading role in organizing the Indigenous Ayahuasca Conference, helping shape Indigenous-led agendas and strategies for biocultural rights. The institute also advocates globally against biopiracy and the commodification of Indigenous wisdom, emphasizing ethical frameworks grounded in free, prior, and informed consent, as defined by ILO Convention 169. Through its work, Yorenka has become an international reference point for intercultural dialogue and Indigenous-led environmental leadership.


