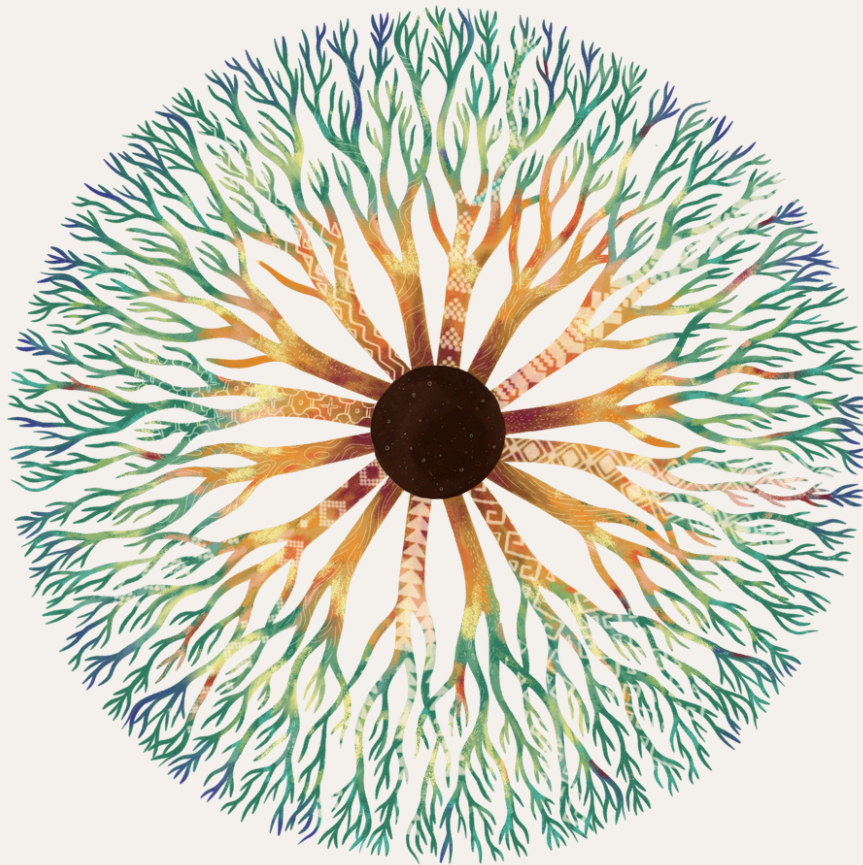

We won't pretend the timing is easy. War, economic fracture, political chaos. Everything about this moment makes organizing a global Indigenous-led gathering harder. But that is exactly why this matters now. Not despite the chaos. Because of it.



At the root of this gathering is something the leaders hold as sacred and urgent: the ancestral knowledge systems and medicines - such as ayahuasca - that have sustained their peoples and the balance of Life for millennia. They are living sciences, the pillars of biocultures that must be met with recognition, protection, and deep ethical care. As these traditions reach every corner of the world, **the leaders are calling for partnership.**

Why this gathering? *Because partnership requires a place to land.*

The Indigenous leadership behind this Forum is calling us to step into a **New Time of Alliance**. A fundamental question is being put on the table: **How can our worlds truly partner to address the critical issues we face as a shared humanity?**

The mandate is clear: bring together ancestral knowledge holders from 20 Indigenous nations with people from around the world who carry a deep commitment to building a world in balance - from the fields of systems change, regeneration, philanthropy, healing, science, policy, psychedelic medicine, and community building.

The spiritual leaders are requesting us all to join forces.

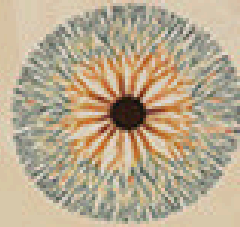

Who we Are



ICEERS is a nonprofit organization dedicated to the safe and ethical integration of Indigenous plant medicines in contemporary societies. For over 15 years, it has worked at the intersection of grassroots movements, Indigenous communities, and policy-makers, advocating for the recognition of traditional medicines as legitimate cultural practices. ICEERS supports legal defense, crisis intervention, and harm reduction, while co-creating community-led regulatory frameworks rooted in cultural and ecological integrity. Through initiatives like the Community Practices Framework and the Alliance of Knowledge Systems, the organization promotes intercultural dialogue, epistemic diversity, and shared stewardship. ICEERS has published over 100 educational resources and has supported thousands worldwide through its legal and crisis support programs, helping shape safer, more respectful, and culturally grounded plant medicine futures.

The **Yorenka Tasorentsi Institute**, founded in 2018 by Ashaninka leader Benki Piyãko, is an Indigenous-led center for ecological regeneration, cultural revitalization, and political advocacy. Located in the Brazilian Amazon, the institute blends traditional Ashaninka knowledge with innovative agroforestry and sustainability practices to restore biodiversity and support food security in the region. Yorenka serves as a hub for environmental education, Indigenous self-determination, and the protection of sacred medicines and ancestral knowledge systems. It plays a leading role in organizing the Indigenous Ayahuasca Conference, helping shape Indigenous-led agendas and strategies for biocultural rights. The institute also advocates globally against biopiracy and the commodification of Indigenous wisdom, emphasizing ethical frameworks grounded in free, prior, and informed consent, as defined by ILO Convention 169. Through its work, Yorenka has become an international reference point for intercultural dialogue and Indigenous-led environmental leadership.

Join This New Time of Alliance

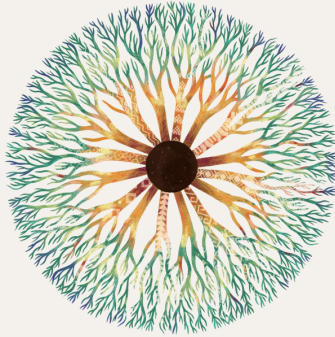
